# CAMP GUIDELINES

- All campers must abide by the schedule unless excused by the dean
- All campers need the dean's permission to leave the camp property
- The use of tobacco, intoxicants, any illegal drugs is strictly prohibited
- Sickness and injury must be reported to the camp medical person at once
- Dress modestly (Bare midriffs, short shorts or skirts, writing on the backside of shorts or pants nor tight apparel are permitted. One-piece swimsuits should be worn by females unless covered by a dark t-shirt. Shirts are to be worn in public by males at all times except while swimming.)
- Campers are not allowed to leave any off-campus activity areas
- Camper vehicles must be parked in designated areas and left parked and unoccupied for the duration of the week.
- Campers may be sent home early for misconduct. A parent or guardian will be responsible for transportation home.

## ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

- All campers must check in at the chapel before entering the dorms (Please do not arrive on campus early)
- Camp cost must be paid in full by registration



## CANTEEN CARDS

All money brought to camp should be exchanged at registration for a canteen card (no cash transactions). It may be used to purchase items during canteen time as well as for mission offerings. Any remaining balance on the card will be donated to that week's mission.
